



OAK Version 3 Installation

Depending upon which version of OAK you currently have installed, the new OAK installer program may ask for: (i) Excel to be shutdown, and/or; (ii) the previous version of OAK to be removed via Add/Remove Programs, which is found with Start | Control Panel.

Once this has been done, a new version is ready to be installed.

There are two ways to get the OAK files onto your PC:

From the Operis website: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Download the .zip file from the OAK webpage at www.operis.com/oak.htm;2. Unzip the files and select the file setup.exe	From a CD: <p>Open the CD contents via 'My Computer' and select the file setup.exe</p>
<p>The OAK Auto-installer will automatically add OAK to your list of Excel Add-Ins, by way of an extra dropdown box in Excel, and will enable a 30-day period to evaluate the software before deciding to purchase a license.</p>	

Licensing your copy of OAK is also very straightforward:

1. Open Excel and go to 'About OAK' in the OAK dropdown menu;
2. Make a note of the 12-digit product ID;
3. Email this number to swilliams@operis.com, who will reply with your license number.
4. If licensing more than one copy, please send the respective user's name.
5. Once you have received the license number, insert the code into the text-box that appears from Step 1 above.

Should you or the user be issued with a new computer, or require the software to be re-installed, the licensing steps above will need to be repeated in order to be issued with a new license number. Naturally, there is no cost for this.
